THE DISCIPLESHIP METHODOLOGY HAS BEEN VERY EFFECTIVE. FROM 389 FOLLOWERS IN DECEMBER 2022, THE FINGER HAS BEEN GROWING FASTER AND FASTER REACHING 612 BY MARCH 2023. THAT IS DUE TO ACTIVITIES AND THE METHODS WE PUT IN PLACE WHICH FAVORS YOUTH. LOOKING FORWARD FOR THE LARGE GROUP/YOUTH CONFERENCE IN FEW MONTHS TO COME.

#### YOUTH EMPOWERMENT

The question might be; why empowering youth in various dimensions? Read below to see some of the approaches Jesus used in his ministry. Malawi is one of the poorest countries in the World. COST realizes the damage our youth go through in terms of health, nutrition, social life, education challenges, and economic crisis among others. In his ministry Jesus was always in shoes of his disciples and all that surrounded him. In Matthew 14:13-21 we see Jesus feeding thousands of men. Was his mission to come on earth and feed them with physical food? Totally NO! We see Jesus also healing the sick. Did he come to heal? No. However he fed, he healed those who followed him. The disciples wanted to send the multitude to go and search food for themselves. Jesus rebuked. He asked the disciples to seek food for the people who came to listen from Jesus. He blessed only three loaves of bread and three fish. The miracle occurred that the food was enough for 5,000 people and there were remnants.

Jesus came to save his people! That's all; Matthew 1:21 – And she shall bring forth a son, and thou shalt call his name JESUS: for he shall save his people from their sins. Thus the main purpose of Jesus's mission hoverer wanted to bring close all the mankind to him, building a better relationship with people through feeding, healing miracles among others.

That is one of the reasons COST ministries find ways and is still searching and means of supporting its disciples and non-disciples in order for them to come all closer and to buy their interest in the ministry. This is also a preaching of love that is also in Jesus Christ.



### **Entrepreneurship trainings, saving groups and loans.**

These youth, young women inclusive are well trained on how they can open small scale businesses and develop a saving culture using the little they earn after trading. Medson takes a great role in preparing and equipping those who were desperate to start a journey of hope making them be reliable and have self-dependability economically.

After a two weeks training groups graduate to be meeting in their respective locations and COST takes a role of supervising them. Tikonde, Zinalikuti and Tithandizane youth groups are enjoying the free benefits of entrepreneurship trainings done.

Some of such groups' trade in fish, Agriculture produces among others.

## Local Chickens pass on project

Local chickens play a major role for the rural poor people and marginalized section of the people with respect to their subsidiary income and also provide them with nutritious chicken eggs, and meat for their own consumption.

Feeding of local chickens is easy than hybrid ones. Most of them are reared using a free range system. Chicken droppings can be used as manure for the farmyard.

Both local chicken breed eggs and meat have a high market across the country. Those are some of the reasons COST in line with THE WAR COUNSEL donate local chicken breeds to our disciples for the benefit of their daily living.





Only ten chickens, five females and five males were distributed to 5 widows in Sauya. We have 30 Offsprings making a total of 40 March 2023. We arranged a pass on program by the end of April 2023 to other 5 members

#### **CHALLENGES**

The ministry, our youth, the church community and our local leaders including the nation have under gone through terrible times. The increasing economic crisis, hunger, the Cyclone Freddy, the previous Convid 19, Cholera among others have distorted good plans that were made.

Lack of enough resources for the COST ministry such as Bibles, travel machines, land for developmental activities, frailer of some projects due to lack of enough funding have made the

work of the past 3 months difficult despite registering a very big number of new youth (Disciples).

Self-sustainability for the organization is required to overcome such challenges. Ideally, farming on our own, opening a kindergarten can bring better results so that we should not always wait for the donors all the time.

After counting the difficult times we have undergone and the future predictions that are at hand, 2023 to 2024 is another challenging period for food. Not many will harvest enough food yet the prices of corn was very high more than 3 time the prices of 2022. If we keep the warning of Joseph by purchasing food for the future, we can easily generate funds and save lives. Read Genesis 40:1-23.

We are but sure God knows how faithful we are before him, and hopefully he shall never forsake us because he knows whom we are, what we do and what we want to do for the uplifting of his kingdom.
